If your business employs a person with a disability you may be eligible for free Disability Awareness Training funded through the Employee Assistance Fund.

Training can be tailored to meet the specific needs of your business and your employees as well as providing general information on disability, workplace accessibility and inclusion.

The training will assist your employees who have a disability to maintain their employment and increase their independence, productivity and quality of work.

Supervisors and coworkers will gain valuable insight into disability and strength based support in the workplace.

To qualify for this free training you must be an employer of a person with a disability and the employee must be employed for a minimum of 8 hours a week for at least 13 weeks.
